Council for the City of Dry Ridge met in regular session on November 17, 2008, at 5:30 p.m. at the Dry Ridge City Building, 31 Broadway, Dry Ridge, Kentucky, 41035, with the following present:

Fred Money, Jason O'Nan, Kenny Edmondson, Karen Glore, Encil Webster, Fire Chief Robert Bruin, Cindy Harris, Bryan Marshall-Grant County News, Diane Reed, Police Chief Rick Kells, City Attorney Michael Mulvey, and Mayor Clay Crupper. Council member Jamie Webster was absent.

Mayor Crupper called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Mayor Crupper welcomed our guests.

Mayor Crupper presented the agenda for approval.

Council member Encil Webster moved, Council member Karen Glore seconded to approve the agenda. Motion carried. Kenny Edmondson-yes, Karen Glore-yes, Fred Money-yes, Jason O'Nan-yes, Encil Webster-yes, Jamie Webster-absent.

Mayor Clay Crupper presented the minutes of November 3, 2008 for Council approval.

Council member Encil Webster noted the amount of calls in the county area versus city limits.

Council member Encil Webster asked Fire Chief Robert Bruin how much Grant County Fiscal Court submitted for their portion of fire protection costs each year.

Fire Chief Robert Bruin noted that \$20,000 was received from the County each year.

Council member Encil Webster stated the City should revisit the amount of support the County was providing for their fire protection area. Council member Kenny Edmondson, Council member Karen Glore, and Mayor Crupper agreed with Council member Encil Webster.

Fire Chief Robert Bruin asked Council for permission to research other billing services to get the most collection. Council and Mayor Crupper agreed the City should check to get the best collection and billing service.

Chief Bruin will research this.

## OLD BUSINESS

### A. CENSUS BUREAU EMPLOYMENT

Mayor Crupper recognized Diane Reed, recruiter for the Census Bureau.

Diane Reed stated jobs for the 2010 census would be starting in January 2009 for 10 weeks to two years for the 2010 census. Pay for one position would be \$13.75 plus mileage and pay for the other position would be \$15.20 plus mileage. Hours range from 20 to 40 per week.

The census count is important for representation in the House of Representatives, road funds, etc.


City Attorney Michael Mulvey read the first reading of the Ambulance Service Fee Ordinance.
