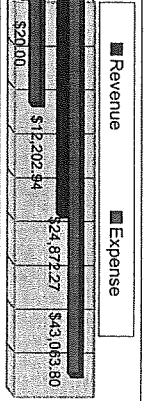
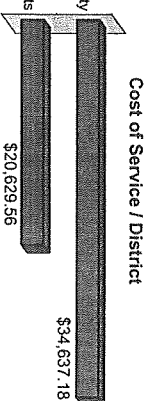

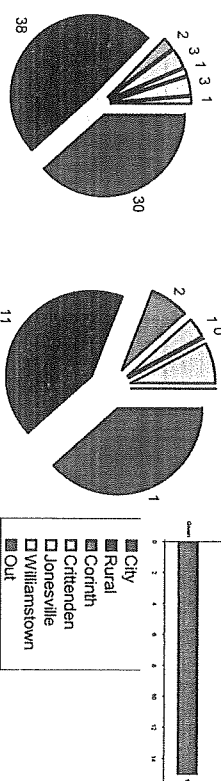

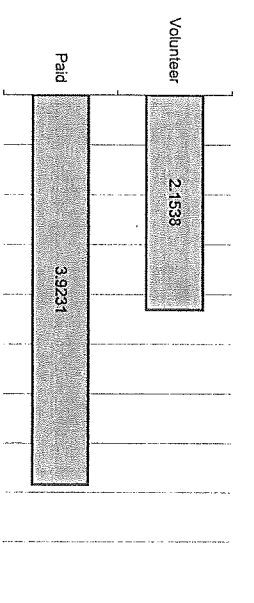


B. SECOND READING ORDINANCE 740-2008 (BEVERAGE TRAINING)
