

ORDINANCE NO. 302-1977

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING YARD AND GARAGE SALES; ESTABLISHING A FEE FOR A PERMIT TO HOLD SUCH SALES; LIMITING THE PERIOD OF TIME SUCH SALES MAY BE HELD; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF SALES WHICH MAY BE HELD IN ONE YEAR; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF

WHEREAS the sale of personal items by means of garage or yard sales has become popular, and

WHEREAS such sales, if protracted, become hazards to the public safety, and an inconvenience to adjoining property owners,

NOW THEREFORE the City Council of the City of Dry Ridge does ordain as follows:

SECTION ONE

Property owners in the City of Dry Ridge may hold as many as two sales per year upon their own property, each sale to last no longer than two days, by obtaining a license at the City Building, the fee for which is \$5.00 for each day of sale.

SECTION TWO

Any person, firm, or corporation or association violating the provisions of this ordinance, shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$100.00, plus court costs, and each day of sale conducted in violation hereof shall constitute a separate offense.
