

ORDINANCE NO. 348-1980

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 303-1977, AND
RAISING THE WATER RATES TO ALL CUSTOMERS IN
DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS, the water rates to the customers of Dry Ridge must yield sufficient revenue to pay for the water consumed, and maintenance and operation costs of the system, and a reserve for emergencies,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE :


SECTION ONE

Ordinance Number 303-1977 is hereby repealed.


SECTION TWO

The minimum water bill shall be Seven Dollars (\$7.00) for the first two thousand (2,000) gallons or fraction thereof used each month. The rate of one dollar and forty cents (\$1.40) per thousand gallons shall apply to the next eight thousand (8,000) gallons consumed over the minimum each month, and the rate of one dollar and twenty cents (\$1.20) per thousand gallons shall apply to all water consumed in excess of ten thousand (10,000) gallons each month.
