

ORDINANCE NO. 395-1984

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR THE CITY
OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
JULY 1983 - JUNE 1984.

WHEREAS, the City of Dry Ridge has received more revenue than expected, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Dry Ridge has received extra revenue in 1983-1984 Fiscal Year and also has outstanding 1983-1984 indebtedness, and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists in that said indebtedness from fiscal year 1983-1984 remains unpaid, and

WHEREAS, this budget for fiscal year 1983-1984 must be amended to reflect the true financial situation for fiscal year 1983-1984.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE:


