

AN ORDINANCE RAISING AND INCREASING THE WATER RATES CHARGED TO ALL CUSTOMERS IN DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY AND AMENDING ORDINANCES NO. 348-1980, SECTION 2 AS HERETOFORE AMENDED AND NO. 367-1981, SECTION ONE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the cost and rate for water supplied to the City of Dry Ridge by the City of Williamstown has been raised and increased by the enactment of Ordinance No. 87-282 and new sections (G)(1) and (2) added to Section 52.08 of the City of Williamstown by enactment of said ordinance on December 18, 1987;

WHEREAS, the water rates charged to the customers of the City of Dry Ridge must yield sufficient revenues to pay for such water consumed, to service the cost and expenses of operation and maintenance of the water system, and to fund the required reserve duly maintained for emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the cost and rates for such water and services provided and supplied to all customers of the City of Dry Ridge must and shall be increased.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE:

SECTION ONE

Section 2 of Ordinance 348-1980 as heretofore amended by Section One of Ordinance No. 367-1981 is amended as follows:

(2) The minimum water bill shall be ~~Eight Dollars-(\$8.00)~~ Eight Dollars and Twenty Cents (\$8.20) for the first Two Thousand (2,000) gallons or fraction thereof used each month. The rate of ~~One Dollar and Sixty-Five Cents-(\$1.65)~~ One Dollar and Seventy-Five Cents (\$1.75) per thousand gallons shall apply to the next Eight Thousand (8,000) gallons consumed over the minimum each month, and the rate of ~~One Dollar and Forty-Two Cents-(\$1.42)~~ One Dollar and Fifty-Two Cents (\$1.52) per thousand gallons shall apply to all water consumed in excess of Ten Thousand (10,000) gallons each month.

SECTION TWO

Section One of the herein Ordinance with the increased charge, rate and rates as so amended and set forth above for water supplied to the customers of the City of Dry Ridge shall be effective with the billing of May 1, 1988, with such newly established rate or rates to be applied and computed against all customers' water usage or water consumed, including the minimum amount or bill billable to a customer, for the month, period or water-usage-unit preceeding the date of 1 May 1988 and so then and thereafter charged and billed to all customers upon their next, succeeding bill or statement for water used and consumed in keeping with the established format, practice and methods for computation of such water usage bills and statements now presently utilized by the accounting and procedures of the City of Dry Ridge so as to enable the City of Dry Ridge to timely pay and remit monies due the City of Williamstown for water provided and supplied by it to the City of Dry Ridge and subject to the said increased rate and charge so established and set forth in and within Ordinance No. 87-282 and new sections (G)(1) and (2) added to Section 52.08, and to further enable the City of Dry Ridge to maintain and fund, by revenues and monies received from all water customers, the funds and accounts required to be established and maintained to service indebtedness, maintain the water system and services provided to all customers and to provide for and meet any emergencies relative to same which may arise.

SECTION THREE

Effective with the water usage-computation-billing period for all water customers of the City of Dry Ridge beginning on May 1, 1989, the cost, charge, rate or rates to be charged to all customers of the City of Dry Ridge as provided for, set forth and established in, within and by Section One of this Ordinance(No. 425-1988) above so amending the water rates and charges as previously provided and established in Section 2 of Ordinance 348-1980 as heretofore amended by Section One of Ordinance No. 367-1981

as the said charges and rates were duly amended and established by Section One of this Ordinance (No. 425-1988), be and the same are hereby amended as follows:

(2) The minimum water bill shall be ~~Eight-Dollars-and-Twenty-Cents-(\$8.20)~~ Eight Dollars and Forty Cents (\$8.40) for the first Two Thousand (2,000) gallons or fraction thereof used each month. The rate of ~~One-Dollar-and-Seventy-Five-Cents-(\$1.75)~~ One Dollar and Eighty-Five Cents (\$1.85) per thousand gallons shall apply to the next Eight Thousand (8,000) gallons consumed over the minimum each month, and the rate of ~~One-Dollar-and-Fifty-Two-Cents-(\$1.52)~~ One Dollar and Sixty-Two Cents (\$1.62) per thousand gallons shall apply to all water consumed in excess of Ten Thousand (10,000) gallons each month.

SECTION FOUR

Section Three of the herein Ordinance with the increased charge, rate and rates as so amended and set forth above for water supplied to the customers of the City of Dry Ridge shall be effective with the billing of May 1, 1989, with such newly established rate or rates to be applied and computed against all customers' water usage or water consumed, including the minimum amount or bill billable to a customer, for the month, period or water-usage-unit preceeding the date of 1 May 1989 and so then and thereafter charged and billed to all customers upon their next, succeeding bill or statement for water used and consumed in keeping with the established format, practice and methods for computation of such water usage bills and statements now presently utilized by the accounting and procedures of the City of Dry Ridge so as to enable the City of Dry Ridge to timely pay and remit monies due the City of Williamstown for water provided and supplied by it to the City of Dry Ridge and subject to the said increased rate and charge so established and set forth in and within Ordinance No. 87-282 and new sections (G)(1) and (2) added to Section 52.08, and to further enable the City of Dry Ridge to maintain and fund, by revenues and monies received from all water customers, the funds and accounts required to be established and maintained to service
