

ORDINANCE NO. 586-1999

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, SO ESTABLISHING THE TARIFF, RATE AND CHARGE FOR SANITARY WATER SERVICES PROVIDED TO ALL CUSTOMERS IN THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE AND AMENDING CITY OF DRY RIDGE ORDINANCE NO. 553-1997.

WHEREAS, the tariff and water rates charged to customers of the City of Dry Ridge must yield sufficient revenues to pay the costs incurred by the city to purchase water from the city's suppliers and to maintain the city's water system and facilities; and

WHEREAS, the cost for water supplied to the City of Dry Ridge has and will be increased along with the costs of maintaining and operating the city's municipal water system and facilities so requiring that a change and amendment to the heretofore established tariff, rates and charges for sanitary water services provided to the city's water customers be now made to equitably defer such increased costs among the city's classes of water customers.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE AS FOLLOWS:

"SECTION THREE"

Section Three of City of Dry Ridge Ordinance No. 553-1997 heretofore enacted and ordained is amended as follows:

(2) The minimum water bill shall be ~~Twelve-Dollars-(\$12.00)-~~ Fourteen Dollars (\$14.00) for the first two thousand (2,000) gallons or fractions thereof used each month. The rate of ~~Three-Dollars-(\$3.00)-~~ Three Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$3.50) per each 1,000 gallons next consumed up to eight thousand (8,000) over the 2,000-gallon monthly minimum; and the rate next of ~~Two-Dollars-and-Fifty-Cents-(\$2.50)-~~ Three Dollars (\$3.00) per each one thousand gallons, or fractional part thereof, shall apply to all water consumed in excess of ten thousand (10,000) each month.

"SECTION FOUR"

The tariff, rates and charges for sanitary water services provided to customers of the City of Dry Ridge as now established and fixed in Section Three (2) of this Ordinance above, shall be effective upon due passage and publication of this Ordinance as required by law with such established and fixed rates being applied to sanitary water consumed by customers beginning @May 12, 1999, and to be levied, charged and reflected upon customers' bills issued during the July of 1999 billing.
