
C. AUDIT REPORT ACCEPTANCE

Mayor Crupper presented the FY 2010 Audit report for Council acceptance.

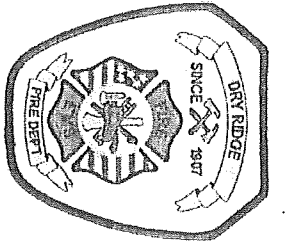
