Council for the City of Dry Ridge met in special session on April 14, 2008 at 5:30 p.m. at the Dry Ridge City Building, 31 Broadway, Dry Ridge, Kentucky, 41035, with the following present:

Mayor Crupper called the meeting to order.

Mayor Crupper welcomed our guests.

Mayor Crupper presented the minutes from March 17, 2008, for approval.

Council member Fred Money moved, Council member Kenny Edmondson seconded to approve the minutes of March 17, 2008. Motion carried. Kenny Edmondson-yes, Mathew Hicks-yes, Fred Money-yes, Jason O'Nan-yes, Jamie Webster-yes.

Mayor Crupper presented the minutes from March 24, 2008 for approval.

Council member Jason O'Nan moved, Council member Mathew Hicks seconded to approve the minutes of March 24, 2008. Motion carried. Kenny Edmondson-yes, Mathew Hicks-yes, Fred Money-yes, Jason O'Nan-yes, Jamie Webster-yes.

## NEW BUSINESS

### A. TATOOING MOBILE UNIT

Mayor Crupper recognized Hargis Davis owner of a mobile tattooing unit, The Lazy Dragon.

Mr. Davis stated that he wanted to operate his mobile tattooing unit, which was legally licensed in Kentucky, in the City of Dry Ridge from time to time.

Mr. Davis asked about zoning where tattooing would be permitted in a mobile unit.

City Attorney Michael Mulvey stated that the City of Dry Ridge Zoning Ordinance did not have tattooing listed as a permitted use.

Mr. Hargis thanked Council and Mayor Crupper stating he had his question answered and left.

Mr. William King, owner of Dry Ridge BP, located at 65 Broadway, who wanted to allow the mobile unit to park on his lot and open for business, also left the meeting.

Council member Jamie Webster arrived at 5:42 p.m.

## B. ZONING

Mayor Crupper stated the City of Dry Ridge Zoning Ordinance required four parking spaces per apartment.

Mayor Crupper recognized Betty Lawrence, property owner on Warsaw Avenue.

Betty Lawrence stated they had a contract on their property to sell to construct apartments; however, there was not enough room to construct the apartments with four parking spaces. Betty Lawrence felt that three parking spaces would be sufficient for adequate parking.

Council, City Attorney Michael Mulvey, and Maintenance Superintendent/Zoning Officer Bobby Robbins discussed the off street parking regulations for all zones.

Council member Fred Money moved, Council member Mathew Hicks seconded to submit a change on off street parking for apartments lowering this from the required four to three spaces. Motion carried. Kenny Edmondson-yes, Mathew Hicks-yes, Fred Money-yes, Jason O'Nan-yes, Jamie Webster-yes.

City Attorney Michael Mulvey stated that an application would be filed with Grant County Planning and Zoning for a public hearing, the issue would return to the City of Dry Ridge for a public hearing, after which an ordinance would be prepared, a first reading, and a separate meeting where a second reading would be held before Council would vote, an Ordinance to change the parking signed and advertised before a site plan with only three parking spaces should be submitted for approval.

## C. RESOLUTION ADOPTING BIASED BASED POLICING AND DOMESTIC VIOLENCE POLICY

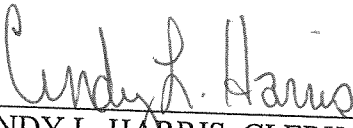
