CITY COUNCIL MEETING
MAY 2, 2011

Council for the City of Dry Ridge met in special session on May 2, 2011, at 7:00 p.m. at the Dry Ridge City Building, 31 Broadway, Dry Ridge, Kentucky, 41035, with the following present:

Fred Money, Jamie Webster, Karen Glore, Judy Curry, Kenny Edmondson, Bryan Marshall-Grant County News, Assistant Fire Chief Jeff Nantz, Bobby Robbins, Kenneth Ball, Cindy Harris, Michael Mulvey, and Mayor Clay Crupper.

Mayor Crupper called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Crupper welcomed our guests.

City Clerk/Treasurer Cindy Harris took attendance with all five Council present.

Mayor Crupper presented the minutes of April 4, 2011 for approval.

Council member Karen Glore moved, Council member Judy Curry seconded to approve the minutes of April 4, 2011. Motion carried. Judy Curry-yes, Kenny Edmondson-yes, Karen Glore-yes, Fred Money-yes, Jamie Webster-yes.

REPORTS

Mayor Crupper stated the Post Office had moved.

Mayor Crupper stated the City would be letting bids for the sidewalk project. Mayor Crupper stated the State could not find their easement. Maintenance Superintendent Bobby Robbins had to obtain easements signed from all of the property owners. The State has now stated the City must get appraisals of the property where the sidewalk is to be constructed. Then waivers for the easements for monetary reimbursement for the property to be utilized will have to be obtained.

Maintenance Superintendent Bobby Robbins stated in reality the State has a 30 foot easement there.

There will have to be a 10% bond for the \$80,000 project and a state approved contractor.

Mayor Crupper stated he wanted a local contractor to get the work but they would have to be state approved.

OLD BUSINESS

A. APPOINTMENT OF NEW COUNCIL MEMBER

Mayor Crupper stated the City advertised for a Council member.

Mayor Crupper stated only John Renaker applied.

Council member Fred Money moved to approve John Renaker as the new Council member to fill the unexpired term of Encil Webster.

Motion died for lack of a second.

Mayor Crupper asked City Attorney Michael Mulvey to send the Governor a letter letting him know that he needed to appoint a Council member to fill the unexpired term of Encil Webster.

NEW BUSINESS

A. FIRST READING ORDINANCE 760-2011 FY 2012 BUDGET

Mayor Crupper stated the utility fund revenues and expenditures balanced this year.

Mayor Crupper stated the City of Dry Ridge can not keep dipping into the reserves. Mayor Crupper stated the County will either pay some of the costs or the ambulance will have to stay in the City of Dry Ridge in the future and reduce or keep the budget the same.

All of the General Fund was decreased for next year.

Council members discussed reducing services provided outside of the City for ambulance services. Without additional funding the Fire Department budget will have to be further reduced again next year.

Mayor Crupper and Assistant Fire Chiefs have met with a member of Fiscal Court to discuss the lack of funding from the County for ambulance services provided to the County from the City.

Mayor Crupper has also met with Judge Link about the lack of funding.

B. CONDITIONAL APPROVAL OF SOLID WASTE BID

Council member Fred Money moved, Council member Karen Glore seconded to approve conditionally the solid waste bid with CSI. Motion carried. Judy Curry-yes, Kenny Edmondson-yes, Karen Glore-yes, Fred Money-yes, Jamie Webster-yes.
