##### A. SECOND READING ORDINANCE 754-2010 TEXT AMENDMENT ZONING ORDINANCE FOR PIERCING/TATOOING

City Attorney Michael Mulvey read the second reading of Ordinance 754-2010 for a text amendment to the Zoning Ordinance permitting piercing and tattooing in Central Business, Highway Commercial, and Neighborhood Commercial zones.

City Council member Karen Glore moved, Council member Kenny Edmondson seconded to approve Ordinance 754-2010. Motion carried. Judy Curry-absent, Kenny Edmondson-yes, Karen Glore-yes, Fred Money-yes, Encil Webster-yes, Jamie Webster-absent.

A. CRUISE IN

Mayor Crupper recognized Joni Pelfrey, resident of Race Street, who asked to be placed on the agenda.

Joni Pelfrey presented a petition requesting either the Cruise In be relocated or only held once a year.

Council stated they had granted permission for the 2010 cruise in and the Car Club had their necessary permit and insurance. Council stated the only street affected was Church Street.

Council and Mayor Crupper stated that anyone coming to Church Street or the drugstore should be able to enter at Race Street and exit downtown. One way is necessary for safety. Mayor Crupper assured the residents of Church Street-Joy Henry, Judy Donley, and Stephanie Henry they and any of their guests should be able to enter and exit their street.

Resident Joy Henry asked about the music.


