Council for the City of Dry Ridge met in regular session on August 17, 2009, at 5:30 p.m. at the Dry Ridge City Building, 31 Broadway, Dry Ridge, Kentucky, 41035, with the following present:

Fred Money, Jason O'Nan, Kenny Edmondson, Karen Glore, Encil Webster, Jamie Webster, Cindy Harris, Brian Marshall-Grant County News, City Attorney Michael Mulvey, Water Superintendent Jamey Rhoton, Sewer Superintendent Ken Little, and Mayor Clay Crupper.

Mayor Crupper called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Mayor Crupper welcomed our guests.

City Clerk/Treasurer Cindy Harris took attendance with all six Council present.

Mayor Crupper presented the agenda for approval.

Council member Jamie Webster moved, Council member Jason O'Nan seconded to approve the agenda. Motion carried. Kenny Edmondson-yes, Karen Glore-yes, Fred Money-yes, Jason O'Nan-yes, Encil Webster-yes, Jamie Webster-yes.

Mayor Clay Crupper presented the minutes of August 3, 2009 for Council approval.

Council member Encil Webster moved, Council member Karen Glore seconded to approve the minutes of August 3, 2009. Motion carried. Kenny Edmondson-yes, Karen Glore-yes, Fred Money-yes, Jason O'Nan-yes, Encil Webster-yes, Jamie Webster-yes.

REPORTS

WATER

Mayor Crupper stated he received a call around 6:00 a.m. concerning water pressure. Mayor Crupper stated Jamey Rhoton and Ken Little were already out looking for the break. Mayor Crupper stated a customer came in to Speedway when Jamey Rhoton and Ken Little met at Speedway and reported water near Donnie Gibson's barn on Taft Highway.

Water Superintendent Jamey Rhoton stated about 17 feet of pipe was broke. Jamey Rhoton stated he took samples to Lexington late Monday. A boil water advisory for the entire town was issued.

MAYOR

Mayor Clay Crupper asked if Council wanted to attend the NKADD annual dinner August 24, 2009. Mayor Crupper, his wife Mary, and Council member Karen Glore will attend.

The next regular Council meeting is cancelled due to the Labor Day holiday. Mayor Crupper and Council will meet on the 2nd Monday, September 14, at 5:30 p.m. for a special meeting for the second readings on both the 2009 real and personal property tax ordinance and the

2010 watercraft and vehicle tax ordinance, a report on the bid openings and possible award of the bids for heart monitors. Agenda will be set and duly advertised before the meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

- A. ESTABLISH 2009 REAL PROPERTY TAX RATE
- B. ESTABLISH 2009 PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX RATE

Mayor Crupper stated he wanted to adopt the compensating rate plus 4% increase for both the real and personal property tax rate.

City Attorney Michael Mulvey stated the real property compensating tax rate plus 4% increase would be .2220 per \$100 of assessed value and the personal property compensating tax rate plus 4% increase would be \$.1810 per \$100 of assessed value.

City Clerk/Treasurer Cindy Harris stated Dana Manufacturing kept around \$24,000,000 of manufactured finished goods in January 2008 which they had not shipped and had to report for 2008 personal property which forced the 2008 personal tax rate to decrease to about \$.13 per \$100 of assessed value. This year the manufactured finished goods were much lower which increased the compensating rate.

Council member Encil Webster moved, Council member Jason O'Nan seconded to adopt a 2009 real property tax rate of \$.2220 per \$100 of assessed value and a 2009 personal property tax rate of \$.1810 per \$100 of assessed value, compensating rate plus 4%. Motion carried. Kenny Edmondson-yes, Karen Glore-yes, Fred Money-yes, Jason O'Nan-yes, Encil Webster-yes, Jamie Webster-yes.

- C. FIRST READING 2009 REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX RATE ORDINANCE

City Attorney Michael Mulvey read the first reading of the 2009 real and personal property tax rate ordinance.

A tax hearing will be properly noticed and held on September 3, 2009.

- D. ESTABLISH 2010 WATERCRAFT AND MOTOR VEHICLE TAX RATE

City Attorney Michael Mulvey stated state law would require the vehicle tax rate to be set at \$.29 per \$100 for Dry Ridge.

City Council member Kenny Edmondson moved, Council member Fred Money seconded to establish the 2010 motor vehicle and watercraft tax rate to be set at \$.29 per \$100 of assessed value. Motion carried. Kenny Edmondson-yes, Karen Glore-yes, Fred Money-yes, Jason O'Nan-yes, Encil Webster-yes, Jamie Webster-yes.

- E. FIRST READING 2010 WATERCRAFT AND MOTOR VEHICLE TAX RATE ORDINANCE

City Attorney Michael Mulvey read the first reading of the 2010 motor vehicle and watercraft tax ordinance.


- F. SEWER REQUEST 201 PLAN GRANT COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT

Council reviewed the 201 maps. Council discussed trading properties with the Grant County Sanitation District which would change the existing 201 plan.

Fire Chief Robert Bruin arrived after a fire call. Chief Bruin stated he would advertise to accept and open bids for the heart monitors on September 14th and plan to review and issue a recommendation for purchase at the special Council meeting on September 14, 2009.
