Council for the City of Dry Ridge met in special session on August 30, 2010, at 5:30 p.m. at the Dry Ridge City Building, 31 Broadway, Dry Ridge, Kentucky, 41035, with the following present:

Judy Curry, Fred Money, Karen Glore, Encil Webster, Kenny Edmondson, Jamie Webster, Bryan Marshall-Grant County News, Ken Little, Jamey Rhoton, Cindy Harris, Michael Mulvey, and Mayor Clay Crupper.

Mayor Crupper called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Mayor Crupper welcomed our guests.

City Clerk/Treasurer Cindy Harris took attendance with all six Council members being present.

Mayor Clay Crupper presented the minutes of July 19, 2010 for approval.

Council member Encil Webster moved, Council member Karen Glore seconded to approve the minutes of July 19, 2010. Motion carried. Judy Curry-yes, Kenny Edmondson-yes, Karen Glore-yes, Fred Money-yes, Encil Webster-yes, Jamie Webster-yes.

NEW BUSINESS

A. SELECTION OF ENGINEERING FIRM SIDEWALK GRANT PROJECT

Mayor Crupper stated the committee had to read and score each of six engineering firms that had submitted to the City. The committee of Ken Little, Jamey Rhoton, and Mayor Crupper had read through each proposal on Friday, August 27, 2010. They selected three engineering firms and then chose one of the three firms to recommend to Council.

Mayor Crupper stated the committee recommended Kenvirons, Inc.

Council member Fred Money moved, Council member Encil Webster seconded to select Kenvirons, Inc. as the engineering firm for the sidewalk grant project. Motion carried. Judy Curry-yes, Kenny Edmondson-yes, Karen Glore-yes, Fred Money-yes, Encil Webster-yes, Jamie Webster-yes.

Mayor Crupper stated he planned to enter into a contract with Kenvirons, Inc. before the Labor Day holiday.

B. 2010 REAL AND PERSONAL TAX RATE ORDINANCE

Council reviewed information on the 2010 tax rates. Mayor Crupper and Council discussed the huge loss of assessment at the Dry Ridge Outlet Mall and also at Hogans Mill subdivision. Grant County PVA Angie McLafferty is appealing with the State the assessment of the Dry Ridge Outlet Center, but this will be in December or January before this issue is reheard.

Council member Encil Webster moved, Council member Jamie Webster seconded to adopt the compensating tax rate plus a 4% increase at a rate of \$.243 per \$100 of assessed real estate and a personal property tax rate of \$.216 per \$100 of assessed personal property for 2010. Motion carried. Judy Curry-yes, Kenny Edmondson-yes, Karen Glore-yes, Fred Money-yes, Encil Webster-yes, Jamie Webster-yes.

The City will advertise and hold a tax hearing on September 16, 2010, from 4:00 to 5:00 p.m.

C. FIRST READING 2010 REAL AND PERSONAL TAX RATE ORDINANCE

City Attorney Michael Mulvey read the first reading of Ordinance 756-2010 establishing a real estate tax rate of \$.243 per \$100 of assessed value and a personal property tax rate of \$.216 per \$100 of assessed value.


D. FIRST READING ORDINANCE 755-2010 AUTOMOBILE/WATERCRAFT TAXES

City Attorney Michael Mulvey read the first reading of Ordinance 755-2010 setting the 2011 automobile and watercraft tax rate at \$.29 per \$100 of assessed value.
