Sorry I was on the phone when you called. I did not know you left a message until after you closed.


It is not in the best interest of the Housing Authority to obtain what might be claimed later to be incriminating evidence to serve the interest of a plaintiff's lawyer.

Assuming the mold has been removed and thrown away, what would they have us to sample? If the lawyer wants to invest in this kind of unreliable evidence, it is up to him to obtain it and to pay for it. We can refute it at trial. You are under no obligation to help him win his case with junk science.

Evidence of mold will be retrievable by sampling in every environment whether or not there is a mold hazard. If I were to collect samples, they will come back positive for mold even if the potential mold hazard has been eliminated.
