The area must be roped off for pedestrian traffic which must be directed to the other side of the road unless for (4) or more feet of sidewalk width remains unobstructed. This can be done with cones, barricades and/or flagging tape. Encroachment and Restoration Activity

- At any time applicant disturbs the yard, residence, or other real or personal property, applicant shall ensure that the impacted property is retuned, replaced, and/or restored to a condition that is sufficiently comparable to the condition that existed prior to the commencement of work.
- The cost associated with both the disturbance and the return, replacement, and/or restoration shall be borne by the applicant.
- The requirements imposed shall extend to any subcontractor or independent contractor that the applicant might employ to perform the tasks outlined in this section.
- However the operator has the authority to diligently trim trees of a private property owner (including subscriber) which overhang or intrude into the right-of-way or easements, but only to the extent necessary to prevent the branches of the trees from coming in contact with applicant's equipment.
