Hi Jim,

I'm following up on Susan's conversation with you about our request to use Piddle Park as a new location for our Fueling the Mind outreach program this summer. We are really excited about the park being a new location and we're looking forward to the opportunity to reach some new kids this year.

Just so that you have the particulars, we'll be at the park every day, Monday through Friday, for eight weeks from June 5th to July 28th. The only day we wouldn't be there is July 4th since the library will be closed for the holiday. Piddle Park will be one of five Fueling the Mind locations in the county. We're still working on the times for each site, but the free lunch will be served for 30 to 45 minutes followed by a short library program or activity and the chance for kids in attendance to check out library books. There will be at least two library staff members there each day for no more than an hour and half.

We're able to serve the lunches for free through a partnership with the Grant County Schools Food Service. Children who can eat for free are classified as all ages from babies to 18 years old. Adults in attendance can eat for \$2. The food is paid for through a federal grant that the food service office applies for each year. Part of the grant application asks for the physical address of each outreach site. Can you let me know what address we should use for Piddle Park?

Please let me know if you have any questions for us. I'll be in touch with more details as we go along.
