JANUARY 19, 2009

Council for the City of Dry Ridge met in regular session on January 19, 2009 at 5:30 p.m. at the Dry Ridge City Building, 31 Broadway, Dry Ridge, Kentucky, 41035, with the following present:

Mayor Crupper called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

## REPORTS

### FIRE

Chief Bruin stated that he wanted to purchase an automatic CPR unit. It can be paid for in next year's budget. Chief Bruin stated that Lexington had been using this for about 2 years. Chief Bruin stated that although the automatic CPR unit was expensive, if it saved one life it would be worth it. Chief Bruin discussed how difficult, especially on country roads, it was to perform CPR in the back of an ambulance with the area being rural and the distance the Fire Department must travel to reach a patient and get them to a hospital.

Chief Bruin stated this was in the budget, but Mayor Crupper asked that Council grant permission before purchasing the unit due to the cost of the unit.

Council member Encil Webster moved, Council member Fred Money seconded to purchase the automatic CPR unit. Motion carried. Kenny Edmondson-absent, Karen Glore-yes, Fred Money-yes, Jason O'Nan-yes, Encil Webster-yes, Jamie Webster-yes.

Council member Encil Webster stated Chief Bruin and the Dry Ridge Fire Department hosted a great symposium this past weekend. Attendance was 105 including Dry Ridge personnel.

## OLD BUSINESS

### A. COMMERCIAL PARKING (ZONING ORDINANCE)

Council, Rex Benson, Maintenance Superintendent Bobby Robbins, and City Attorney Michael Mulvey discussed the parking requirements for the Dry Ridge Sunoco at length.

City Attorney Michael Mulvey stated there is not enough parking to allow closing parking spaces and adding another business, even though it is temporary, according to the parking requirements stated in the Zoning Ordinance.

### B. PERMITTED OCCUPATIONS

Mayor Crupper stated that fireworks as a permitted occupation was discussed on October 7, 2008.

Council, Mayor Crupper, Rex Benson, Zoning Official Bobby Robbins, and City Attorney Michael Mulvey discussed the issue of the sale of fireworks.

Mayor Crupper stated he wanted the City to request a text amendment to include sale of fireworks in all three business zones.
