NOVEMBER 7, 2011

Council for the City of Dry Ridge met in regular session on November 7, 2011, at 7:00 p.m. at the Dry Ridge City Building, 31 Broadway, Dry Ridge, Kentucky, 41035, with the following present:

Mayor Crupper called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Crupper welcomed our guests. Guests were: Jamie Baker-Nantz-Grant County News.

City Clerk/Treasurer Cindy Harris took attendance with all five Council members being present.

Mayor Clay Crupper presented the agenda for approval.

Council member Karen Glore moved, Council member Fred Money seconded to approve the agenda. Motion carried. Judy Curry-yes, Kenny Edmondson-yes, Karen Glore-yes, Fred Money-yes, John Renaker-yes.

Mayor Clay Crupper presented the minutes of October 3, 2011 for approval.

Council member Kenny Edmondson moved, Council member John Renaker seconded to approve the minutes of October 3, 2011. Motion carried. Judy Curry-yes, Kenny Edmondson-yes, Karen Glore-yes, Fred Money-yes, John Renaker-yes.

REPORTS

MAYOR

City Clerk/Treasurer Cindy Harris reported that \$355,333 of \$456,115 billed for 2011 property taxes were collected to date. Some previous years have been collected but still some remain unpaid after several notices have been sent. Council said to go ahead and advertise the taxes.

Council member Kenny Edmondson and Fred Money thanked Maintenance for tree trimming, cleaning the park and general cleanup of the City. Council member Kenny Edmondson asked about remove of the dirt pile in the park. Maintenance Superintendent Bobby Robbins said he could remove this. Council discussed the height of landscaping and the related visibility issue at Country Grill, Arby's, and Microtel. Council member Fred Money also asked about the height of the drop off of the shoulder of the roadway on McCoy Road.

Council stated several compliments had been received about improvements in the appearance of the town.

OLD BUSINESS

A. SIGNS

Council and City Attorney Michael Mulvey discussed removal of temporary signs which are not permitted by the Zoning Ordinance.

Council instructed Maintenance to remove all temporary signs with the exception of those allowed (political) and yard sale signs must be removed by Monday each week. Council instructed Maintenance to keep these signs in the Maintenance building for a reasonable amount of time perhaps a few weeks then if not claimed they can be discarded. These can be easily monitored and collected as water work orders are completed, pump stations checked, etc.

NEW BUSINESS

A. COUNCIL MEMBER

City Attorney Michael Mulvey advised Council that Jamie Webster's resignation had been accepted October 3, 2011, and tonight was the 7th, longer than 30 days had lapsed for Council to fill this vacancy. The Governor will have to appoint.

Five applicants were received: Carissa Hughett, Ron Maddox, Ryan Spalding, Jim Hendy, Jim Wells.

Council had reviewed the applicants submitted.

Council member John Renaker asked if Carissa was Donna Sue's daughter. Upon affirmative answer from another Council member and Mayor Crupper, Council member John Renaker recommended Carissa Hughett to fulfill the vacancy.

Council member Karen Glore recommended Jim Hendy to fill the vacancy. Council member Kenny Edmondson spoke on behalf of Jim Hendy especially the amount of time of his residency in town. Council member Fred Money spoke on behalf of Jim Hendy's personality and his integrity.

City Attorney Michael Mulvey will notify the Governor in writing about the unfilled vacancy.

B. APPOINTMENT AND APPROVAL OF HOUSING BOARD MEMBER

Mayor Crupper recommended Randy Middleton to fill the expired of Rick Ryan, who does not reside within the City of Dry Ridge, for the Housing Board for a four year term.

Council member Fred Money moved, Council member John Renaker seconded to approve the appointment of Randy Middleton to a four year term on the Housing Board. Motion carried. Judy Curry-yes, Kenny Edmondson-yes, Karen Glore-yes, Fred Money-yes, John Renaker-yes.


C. BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT VACANCY
