

ORDINANCE NO. 313, 1977

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCES NO. 137, 155, 169 and 192 FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATIVE BODY, THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND CERTAIN OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS, it has been determined that Ordinances 137, 155, 169 and 192 heretofore passed by the City Council of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky need repealing and that the City needs a new ordinance for compensation in lieu thereof.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE

That Ordinances No. 137, 155, 169 and 192, be, and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION TWO

That each duly elected member of the Legislative Body, except the Chief executive of the City, of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, be and the same are hereby ordered to receive as compensation for their services the sum of TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) per month. Said compensation shall be paid annually at the last regular meeting of each calendar year.

SECTION THREE

The duly elected Chief Executive Officer of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, be and is hereby ordered and directed to receive as compensation for his services the sum of TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2000.00) per year. Said compensation shall be paid annually at the end of each calendar year.

SECTION FOUR

All other City employees' salaries shall be fixed every two (2) years by the City Council of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky.

SECTION FIVE

All ordinances, resolutions, or parts thereof in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION SIX

If any section, clause or paragraph of this ordinance be declared to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining sections, clauses


or paragraphs hereof, it being hereby expressly declared that said remainder of said ordinance would have passed despite such invalidity.
