

ORDINANCE NO. 483-1992

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE AMENDING THE OFFICIAL ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, ORDINANCE NO. 380-1982, TO CHANGE THE MINIMUM SIZE AND AREA OF OFF-STREET PARKING SPACES AND TO ESTABLISH A MINIMUM SIZE AND AREA FOR OFF-STREET HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACES AND TO ESTABLISH REQUIRED SIGNS AND MARKINGS FOR SUCH HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACES.

WHEREAS, the Dry Ridge City Council has determined that the now minimum size and for all non-handicapped parking spaces, off-street, as now set forth within Section 11.1 (A) of the City of Dry Ridge's Official Zoning Ordinance, No. 380-1982, should be amended to permit general parking spaces of reduced size and area, and to establish a minimum size and area for all off-street handicapped parking spaces together with providing for conspicuous signs and ground markings to define and delineate handicapped parking areas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE that Section 11.1(A) of the city's Official Zoning Ordinance, No. 380-1982, concerning the minimum size and area for general off-street parking spaces and so further establishing a minimum size and area for off-street handicapped parking spaces and areas together with provisions as to required signs and ground markings for such handicapped parking spaces, be so hereby duly amended and established as follows, to-wit:

Section One

A. Size of Off-Street Parking Spaces - For purposes of this ordinance, one (1) parking space shall be a minimum of ~~two hundred (200) square feet in area~~ one hundred sixty-two (162) square feet in area, exclusive of access drives or aisles, and shall be a minimum of ~~ten (10) feet in width and twenty (20) feet in length~~ nine (9) feet in width and eighteen (18) feet in length. All handicapped parking spaces shall be a minimum of two hundred (200) square feet in area, exclusive of access drives or aisles, and shall be a minimum of ten (10) feet in width and twenty (20) feet in length and all such parking spaces dedicated or required for handicapped parking, shall be conspicuously marked by both signs and ground markings upon the surface of the handicapped parking space/area in letters and symbols so designating such spaces and area for handicapped parking only. Such parking spaces shall have a vertical clearance of at least seven (7) feet.

Section Two

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its due passage and due ordination and publication as required by statute.
