

ORDINANCE NO. 584-1999

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, FIXING AND ESTABLISHING THE ANNUAL SALARY AND COMPENSATION FOR THE ELECTED OFFICE OF COUNCILPERSON OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE FOR THE TERM OF OFFICE BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2001.

WHEREAS, the City of Dry Ridge and environs have and are experiencing continuing growth which requires the city's councilpersons to expend increased time and effort to discharge the duties and responsibilities of office and attend to the business and needs of the city, all for which the said councilpersons should receive adequate and reasonable salary and compensation; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Dry Ridge has so determined that the salary and compensation now payable to and received by the city's councilpersons should be increased for the next elective term of office beginning on January 1, 2001, and hereby so provides for and fixes such new and said salary and compensation for the elected office of Councilperson of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, as hereinafter provided.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE ONE

The salary and compensation for the elected office of Councilperson of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, for the next elective term beginning on the 1st day of January, 2001, is hereby fixed and established at the sum and amount annual of ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$1,500.00) to be received by and payable to each of the city's duly elected councilpersons, in lump and in a single payment, under warrant drawn upon the city's treasury and funds during each calendar-year of the term of office in the month of December, and remitted at the Regular Meeting of City Council in said month of December.
