Council for the City of Dry Ridge met in regular session on May 3, 2010, at 7:00 p.m. at the Dry Ridge City Building, 31 Broadway, Dry Ridge, Kentucky, 41035, with the following present:

Fred Money, Jamie Webster, Karen Glore, Encil Webster, Kenny Edmondson, Bryan Marshall-Grant County News, Rick Van Meter, Cindy Harris, Michael Mulvey, and Mayor Clay Crupper.

Mayor Crupper called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Crupper welcomed our guests.

Mayor Crupper introduced Rick Van Meter.

City Clerk/Treasurer Cindy Harris took attendance with five Council being present. Council member Judy Curry was absent.

Mayor Crupper asked Council to add Item A. First Reading Ordinance 752-2010 Amended FY 2010 Budget and Item B. First Reading Ordinance 753-2010 FY 2011 Budget under New Business.

Council member Encil Webster moved, Council member Fred Money seconded to approve the agenda with the additions. Motion carried. Judy Curry-absent, Kenny Edmondson-yes, Karen Glore-yes, Fred Money-yes, Encil Webster-yes, Jamie Webster-yes.

Mayor Clay Crupper presented the minutes of March 1, 2010 for approval.

Council member Karen Glore moved, Council member Kenny Edmondson seconded to approve the minutes of March 1, 2010. Motion carried. Judy Curry-absent, Kenny Edmondson-yes, Karen Glore-yes, Fred Money-yes, Encil Webster-yes, Jamie Webster-yes.

Mayor Crupper presented the minutes of April 5, 2010 for approval.

Council member Fred Money moved, Council member Jamie Webster seconded to approve the minutes of April 5, 2010. Motion carried. Judy Curry-absent, Kenny Edmondson-yes, Karen Glore-yes, Fred Money-yes, Encil Webster-yes, Jamie Webster-yes.

Mayor Crupper stated there were no reports.

OLD BUSINESS

A. TEXT AMENDMENT TO THE ZONING ORDINANCE FOR PIERCING/TATTOOING

City Attorney Michael Mulvey reviewed with Council the Grant County Planning and Zoning Commission's recommendations from their hearing on March 22, 2010.

City Attorney Michael Mulvey, reading from the Commission's minutes of March 22, 2010, stated the Commission agreed with the City's application regarding the definition of piercing and tattooing.

City Attorney Michael Mulvey stated the Commission recommended different text changes than the City had requested.

City Attorney Michael Mulvey stated the Commission only approved the text amendment for the Central Business and Highway Commercial zones but not the Neighborhood Commercial zone.

Council had requested tattooing and piercing be listed as a permitted use for Central Business, Neighborhood Commercial, and Highway Commercial.

City Attorney Michael Mulvey instructed Council to approve concurring with the definitions, to disapprove of the Commission's findings regarding the text amendment, and to affirm the original application concerning the text amendment.

Council member Karen Glore moved, Council member Fred Money seconded to agree with the Commission's findings for the text amendment regarding the definitions of piercing and tattooing. Motion carried. Judy Curry-absent, Kenny Edmondson-yes, Karen Glore-yes, Fred Money-yes, Encil Webster-yes, Jamie Webster-yes.

Council member Encil Webster moved, Council member Karen Glore seconded not to affirm but to disapprove of the Commission's findings for the text amendment for piercing and tattooing as permitted uses in Central Business and Highway Commercial zones. Motion carried. Judy Curry-absent, Kenny Edmondson-yes, Karen Glore-yes, Fred Money-yes, Encil Webster-yes, Jamie Webster-yes.

Council member Encil Webster moved, Council member Karen Glore seconded to approve the original application to add piercing and tattooing as permitted uses to Central Business, Neighborhood Commercial, and Highway Commercial zones. Motion carried. Judy Curry-absent, Kenny Edmondson-yes, Karen Glore-yes, Fred Money-yes, Encil Webster-yes, Jamie Webster-yes.

City Attorney Michael Mulvey stated he would draft an ordinance to change the Zoning Ordinance, which the Council would have two separate readings. Council would then vote on the Ordinance which amends the text in the original Zoning Ordinance to include piercing and tattooing as permitted uses in CB, NC, and HC zones.

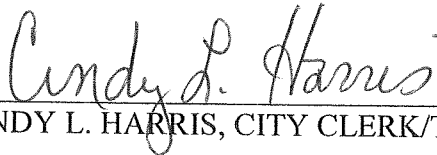
City Attorney Michael Mulvey read the first reading of Ordinance 752-2010 amending FY 2010 Budget.
