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MAY 9, 2011

Council for the City of Dry Ridge met in special session on May 9, 2011, at 5:30 p.m. at the Dry Ridge City Building, 31 Broadway, Dry Ridge, Kentucky, 41035, with the following present:

Fred Money, Jamie Webster, Karen Glore, Judy Curry, Bryan Marshall-Grant County News, Assistant Fire Chief Joe Jamison, Bobby Robbins, Cindy Harris, Michael Mulvey, and Mayor Clay Crupper.

Mayor Crupper called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Mayor Crupper welcomed our guests.

City Clerk/Treasurer Cindy Harris took attendance with four Council present. Council member Kenny Edmondson had a previous commitment.

OLD BUSINESS

B. RESOLUTION CREDIT CARD

Council member Jamie Webster moved, Council member Fred Money seconded to adopt the Resolution changing the credit card authorized user from former Chief Robert Bruin to Assistant Chief Joe Jamison. Motion carried. Judy Curry-yes, Kenny Edmondson-absent, Karen Glore-yes, Fred Money-yes, Jamie Webster-yes.

A. FIRST READING FY 2012 BUDGET ORDINANCE 760-2011

Mayor Crupper stated the Utility Fund and Municipal Aid fund were balanced with expenses equal to or less than revenues for the coming year.

Mayor Crupper stated he did not believe expenditures could be reduced anymore especially within Maintenance and the Park.

Any further reduction in the Police or Administrative Government expenses would mean a reduction in services provided.

Further reduction in the Fire Department could also mean a reduction in staff and services.

Administrative, Police, Public Works, and Parks all have reduced budgets from the current budget.

The Fire Department budget remains the same as the current year without any capital outlay.

Council member Fred Money asked about the expenses for the phone services.

City Clerk Cindy Harris and Assistant Fire Chief Joe Jamison will check with both Insight and Cincinnati Bell to try to reduce the cost.

Council member Fred Money asked about the insurance cost.

City Clerk Cindy Harris stated the cost for next year had not been received yet but last year's Public Officials was \$25,965 and General Liability was \$40,801. There is also property, business auto, and police liability. City Attorney Michael Mulvey and City Clerk Cindy Harris stated insurance costs were shared by various departments in the City.

Mayor Crupper asked if Council members Judy Curry, Karen Glore, and Jamie Webster if they had any questions. They all stated they had no questions.

City Attorney Michael Mulvey read Ordinance 760-2011 Fiscal Year 2012 Budget.
