OLD BUSINESS

A. SECOND READING ORDINANCE 743-2009

City Attorney Michael Mulvey read the second reading of Ordinance 743-2009 repealing the former Solid Waste/Nuisance ordinance 420-1987 which Ordinance 742-2009 just replaced.

B. SECOND READING ORDINANCE 744-2009

City Attorney Michael Mulvey read the second reading of Ordinance 744-2009 amending FY 2009 Budget (741-2009). This amendment was presented to correct the beginning balance forward as stated in the FY 2008 audit.

C. SECOND READING ORDINANCE 745-2009

City Attorney Michael Mulvey read the second reading of Ordinance 745-2009 adopting FY 2010 budget.

Council member Fred Money moved, Council member Encil Webster seconded to adopt Ordinance 745-2009. Motion carried. Kenny Edmondson-yes, Karen Glore-yes, Fred Money-yes, Jason O'Nan-yes, Encil Webster-yes, Jamie Webster-yes.

Council member Encil Webster noted that if projections of expenditures and revenues are correct that City Council members need to devise some additional sources of revenue. Expenditures have already been trimmed unless the City wants to start cutting City services.

Mayor Crupper agreed that the same 4% increase allowed on City real and personal taxes by HB 44 would not do much in the way of increasing revenue each year.

City Attorney Michael Mulvey stated that one City just started eliminating essential services without any notice to its residents. City Attorney Michael Mulvey stated that before the City of Dry Ridge started eliminating services that at least the public needed to be informed if no more revenue was produced and services did have to be eliminated.


D. SECOND READING ORDINANCE 746-2009
