Council for the City of Dry Ridge met in regular session on August 4, 2008 at 7:00 p.m. at the Dry Ridge City Building, 31 Broadway, Dry Ridge, Kentucky, 41035, with the following present:

Council member Encil Webster was absent due to vacation. Council member Jamie Webster was absent due to working out of town.

Mayor Crupper called the meeting to order.

Mayor Crupper welcomed our guests.

Mayor Crupper asked Council to add Item B. US Postal Service Contract under Old Business.

Council member Fred Money moved, Council member Mathew Hicks seconded to approve the agenda with the addition of Item B. US Postal Service Contract under Old Business. Motion carried. NEW BUSINESS

A. HOPPERTON LANE

Mayor Crupper recognized Gary Hopperton, resident of Hopperton Lane.

Gary Hopperton stated he had requested verbally several times to have trees trimmed on the right of way of Hopperton Lane. Gary Hopperton stated he wanted to go on record with his request because he had two close calls, one with a garbage truck and one with a mail carrier.

Maintenance Superintendent Bobby Robbins stated there was no money left to hire a tree trimmer in last year’s budget, but the City had started a new budget on July 1st, 2008.

Maintenance Superintendent Bobby Robbins will obtain two estimates for Mayor Crupper to hire tree trimming on Hopperton Lane. The City of Dry Ridge does not have equipment to reach high enough in order to trim this right of way.

Mayor Crupper stated he would try to complete the tree trimming soon.

OLD BUSINESS

A. DELINQUENT PROPERTY TAXES & FIRST READING DELINQUENT TAX ORDINANCE

City Attorney Michael Mulvey discussed the publication of a list of delinquent taxes each year.

B. US POSTAL SERVICE CONTRACT

Mayor Crupper stated the US Postal Service had requested to extend their Postal Lease on a month to month basis beginning September 2008 for a year.

Council member Fred Money moved, Council member Kenny Edmondson seconded to continue the US Postal Service rental contract for one year on a month to month basis provided City Attorney Michael Mulvey agreed with the contract presented and to authorize Mayor Crupper's signature on behalf of the City. Motion carried. Kenny Edmondson-yes, Mathew Hicks-yes, Fred Money-yes, Jason O'Nan-yes, Encil Webster-absent, Jamie Webster-absent.

REPORTS

Mayor Crupper recognized John Renaker, representative of the Good Old Cruisers Club.

John Renaker requested to extend the second Saturday Cruise in into October 2008.

John Renaker stated the Club would like to continue the cruise-ins next year. John Renaker stated there were no problems except the complaint on the burn out last month.

Mayor Crupper stated that Brent Harpster, with KY Deferred Compensation, had enrolled employees in deferred compensation on July 30 and August 1st.

Mayor Crupper reminded Council of the reservation deadline of August 12th for NKADD annual dinner on August 18th.


There will be no Council meeting on August 18th due to the dinner.
