Council for the City of Dry Ridge met in special session on September 12, 2011, at 5:30 p.m. at the Dry Ridge City Building, 31 Broadway, Dry Ridge, Kentucky, 41035, with the following present:

FIRE

Assistant Chief Joe Jamison presented a printed monthly Fire report to Council.

Mayor Clay Crupper read a letter of resignation from Council member Jamie Webster.

OLD BUSINESS

A. SEATING NEW MEMBER OF COUNCIL JOHN RENAKER

Mayor Crupper stated John Renaker had already been given the "Oath of Office" and sworn in after Governor Beshear appointed him.

City Attorney Michael Mulvey stated he would prepare the letter stating Mr. Renaker had been duly given the "Oath of Office" and sworn in.

B. SECOND READING AND VOTE ORDINANCE 761-2011(2011 REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES)

City Attorney Michael Mulvey read the second reading of Ordinance 761-2011 establishing a rate of \$.244 for 2011 real property taxes and \$.189 for 2011 personal property taxes.

Council member Kenny Edmondson moved, Council member Fred Money seconded to adopt Ordinance 761-2011. Motion carried. Judy Curry-yes, Kenny Edmondson-yes, Karen Glore-yes, Fred Money-yes, John Renaker-yes, Jamie Webster-yes.

C. SECOND READING ORDINANCE 762-2011(2012 AUTO AND WATERCRAFT TAX)

City Attorney Michael Mulvey read the second reading of Ordinance 762-2011 establishing a rate of \$.29 per \$100 for 2012 auto and watercraft tax.

Council member Jamie Webster moved, Council member John Renaker seconded to adopt Ordinance 762-2011 establishing a rate of \$.29 per \$100 for 2012 auto and watercraft in the City limits of Dry Ridge. Motion carried. Judy Curry-yes, Kenny Edmondson-yes, Karen Glore-yes, Fred Money-yes, John Renaker-yes, Jamie Webster-yes.

D. SOLID WASTE COST AND FIRST READING OF ORDINANCE 763-2011 SETTING A RATE FOR SOLID WASTE

Mayor Crupper talked to Council about the small increase in the rate for solid waste collection per customer along with the additional fuel surcharge added to the contract which began July 1, 2011.

The City currently charges each residential customer \$6.20 per month. The two bills received under the new contract cost \$8.04 per customer; however, the monthly fuel surcharge will vary each month according to petroleum charges.

Mayor Crupper suggested the City charge \$8.50 per customer in hopes this would be sufficient.

Council member Judy Curry moved, Council member John Renaker seconded to set the monthly charge for solid waste at \$8.50 per customer per month. Motion carried. Judy Curry-yes, Kenny Edmondson-yes, Karen Glore-yes, Fred Money-yes, John Renaker-yes, Jamie Webster-yes.

City Attorney Michael Mulvey read the first reading of Ordinance 763-2011 establishing the solid waste rate of \$8.50 per customer.
