The Board of Trustees of the Town of Dry Ridge, Grant County, Fentucky, in regular session on Aug. 3, 1943, do ordain as follows;

A tax of Sixty (60) cents on each one hundred (f100.00) follers of value as of July 1. 1947, is hereby levied for the deneral nursose of the Town of Dry Rid e, Ky. upon all real and nersonal estable except such tangible personal property as has an actual bond fide situs without the Town of Pry Ridge or persons domiciled or actually residing in the Town of Dry Rid e on the first day of July, 1943 and of all corporations having their chief offices or places of business in the Town of Dry Ridge. Ky. on said date and all franchises of same, except those exempt from taxation by the constitution or laws of the State of Henticky. And the same shall be assessed at their fair cash value estimated at the price they would bring at a fair voluntary sale. And also all franchises or corporations owned or having their chief offices or places of business outside the Town of Dry Ridge, Kentucky.

There is also levied a poll tax of One (1) Dollar and fifty (50) cents on each male person over twenty one years of age, residing in the Town of Dry Tide, Kentucky.

This ordinance shall take effect after its adoption and bublication as required by law.
