

An Ordinance proposing to annex to the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, certain unincorporated territory lying in Grant County, Kentucky, and adjoining the corporate limits of said city, and accurately describing the boundary of the territory proposed to be annexed.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the City of Dry Ridge Grant County, Kentucky.

Section 1. That it is hereby deemed advisable and it is hereby proposed to annex to the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, all that unincorporated territory lying in Grant County, Kentucky, and adjoining the corporate limits of said City described by metes and bounds as follows; to-wit; Beginning at a point in the old Corporation line of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, which is northwest of the Baptist Parsonage in the line of Harry Hutchinson and the Baptist Parsonage line, Broadway street; said point is 150 feet north of the right-of-way of said Broadway Street, thence in a westerly direction and parallel with Broadway street 987 feet to a point in the line between C. McGee and Iva Conrad; thence in a southerly direction crossing Broadway Street 360 feet to a point in the line of Iva Conrad and E. J. Blackburn, said point is 150 feet south of the south line of the right-of-way of Broadway Street, thence in a easterly direction parallel with Broadway Street 1179 feet to a point in the old corporation line of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, in the line now Hell's Drive; thence in a southerly direction 150 feet west of Race Street and parallel with Race Street 1452 feet to a point in A. J. Lowe and Omer Lowe's line, thence in an easterly direction 1455 feet to a point in the old Corporation line, which is in the school line and A. J. Lowe's line, Lines and lengths of the above are more or less.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be posted (or copies of the same) for at least ten (10) days in four of the most public places in the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, and also published in the County paper for four (4) issues.

Section 3. After the expiration of thirty (30) days from the enactment of this ordinance, and after same shall have been published as is provided in Section Two hereof, if no petition shall have been filed in the Grant County Circuit Court setting forth reasons why the territory defined in Section One of this Ordinance shall not be annexed to the City of Dry Ridge, Ky., the Board of Trustees shall enact an ordinance annexing to the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, the territory defined in Section One of this Ordinance, and upon the enactment of such ordinance, the aforesaid territory shall be annexed to the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, and become a part thereof.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect when signed and recorded and published as required by law.

Ordinance annexing territory provided for
in Ordinance No. 108, page 33

Ordinance #108 which was proposing to annex certain territory to the City of Dry Ridge, Ky. on Nov. 6, 1946. Having been duly published and posted as by law required, since no legal objection was raised to the annexation of said territory. Now therefore be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the City of Dry Ridge, Gr. Co., Ky.

Section 1. That it is hereby deemed advisable and it is hereby proposed to annex to the City of Dry Ridge, Ky., all that unincorporated territory lying in Grant County, Ky., and adjoining the corporate limits of said City described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the old Corporation line of the City of Dry Ridge, Ky., which is northwest of the Baptist Parsonage in the line of Harry Hutchinson and the Baptist Parsonage line, Broadway Street, said point is 150 feet north of the right-of-way of said Broadway Street; thence in a westerly direction and parallel with Broadway Street 987 feet to a point in the line between C. McGee and Iva Conrad, thence in a southerly direction crossing Broadway Street 360 feet to a point in the line of Iva Conrad and E. J. Blackburn, said point is 150 feet south of the south line of the right of way of Broadway Street, thence in an easterly direction parallel with Broadway Street 1179 ft. to a point in the old Corporation line of the City of Dry Ridge, Ky, in Asa Taylor's, now Hall's drive; thence in a southerly direction 150 west of Race Street and parallel with Race Street 1452 ft. to a point in A. J. Lowe's and Omer Lowe's line; thence in a easterly direction 1455 ft. to a point in the old corporation line, which is in the school line and A. J. Lowe's line. Lines and lengths of the above are more or less.

Section 2. This ordinance has been posted (or copies of the same) for ten (10) days in four of the most public places in the City of Dry Ridge, Ky, and also published in the County paper for four (4) issues.

Section 3. After the expiration of thirty (30) days from the enactment of this ordinance, and after same shall have been published as is provided in Section Two hereof if no petition shall

shall have been filed in the Grant County Circuit Court setting forth reason why the territory defined in Section One of this ordinance shall not be annexed to the City of Dry Ridge, Ky. The Board of Trustees shall enact an ordinance annexing to the City of Dry Ridge Ky., the territory defined in Section One of this ordinance, and upon the enactment of such ordinance the aforesaid territory shall be annexed to the City of Dry Ridge, Ky. and become a part thereof.
