The Board of Trustees of the City of Dry Ridge, Crant County, Ky., in regular session on June 3nd, 1947 does ordain as follows:

That each person, firm or corporation setting up and operating a coin operated machine for amusement only, such as pinhall or music machines. Shall pay the amount of license tax of \$5.00 per year on each machine set up and operated by him or them.

Said license must be fastened to each machine while in operation and said license is transferable from one machine to another.

Any person, firm or corporation found guilty of violation of this ordinance shall be fined not less than \$10.00 or more than \$25.00 for each offense, and each day any machine is operated without said license shall constitute a separate offense.

This ordinance does not apply to any gambling or unlawful coin operated machine.

This ordinance shall take effect and be inforce commencing with the 6th day of July, 1947, following its passage and publication as required by law.
