

ORDINANCE NO. 114

The Board of Trustees of the City of Dry Ridge, Grant County, Ky., in Special session on June 12th, 1947, do ordain as follows:

A tax of seventy cents (70¢) on each one Hundred (100) dollars of value as of July 1, 1947, is hereby levied for the general purpose of the City of Dry Ridge, Ky. upon all real and personal estate within the City of Dry Ridge and all personal estate except such tangible personal property as has an accrued bona fide situs without the city of Dry Ridge or persons domiciled or actually residing in the City of Dry Ridge, Ky. on the first day of July, 1947, and of all corporations having their chief offices or places of business in the City of Dry Ridge, Ky. on said date and all franchises of same except those exempt from taxation by the constitution or laws of the State of Kentucky. And the same shall be assessed at their fair cash value estimated at the price they would bring at a fair voluntary sale, and also all franchises or corporations owned or having their chief offices or places of business outside the City of Dry Ridge, Ky.

This ordinance includes those annexed in the South section of town by Ordinance #107 and also the west and south sections annexed by Ordinance #108.

There also is levied a poll tax of (1) One dollar and fifty cents on each male person over twenty-one years of age, residing in the city of Dry Ridge, Ky.

This Ordinance shall take effect after its adoption and publication as required by law.
