

ORDINANCE NO. 117

The Board of Trustees of the City of Dry Ridge, Ky. in regular session for business Tuesday, July 6th, 1948, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That street in the city limits of Dry Ridge, Ky., running south from the Taft Highway, a distance of 650 feet more or less known and designated on the map or plat book as Church Street, said plat is recorded in plat book #1 in the Grant County Clerk's office in Williamstown, Ky. Said street is strictly a residential street and the sidewalks to be built on said street by the abutting property owners shall be constructed in compliance with the following specifications.

Section 2. Said sidewalk shall begin at the property line and extend toward the street on both the east and west side of said street a distance of four feet, not less four inches thick, and shall run the entire length of said street, said sidewalk shall be built so that the top surface of said sidewalk shall be on a level with the center or crown of said street the entire length of said sidewalk.

Section 3. Curbing, There shall be a curb constructed two feet and six inches outside of east and west line of sidewalk the entire length of the street, said curb shall be six inches thick making the outside of said curb three feet from the outside of sidewalk, said curb shall be eighteen inches deep and the top of said curb shall be on a level with the top surface of the sidewalk, this curb is to be eighteen deep so that when the street between the curb is graded and surfaced the outside of said curb will be six inches high above the finished street, except driveways which will have what is known as a low curb similar to the ones on Broadway Street.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its publication as required by law, and any of the above mentioned construction of sidewalks and curbing that is not completed on or before July 1st, 1950, will be constructed by the City of Dry Ridge, Ky. and the cost thereof levied against the abutting property owner or owners as the case may be.
