

ORDINANCE NO. 119

The Board of Trustees of the City of Dry Ridge, Ky. in regular session on May 3rd, 1949, do ordain as follows:

A tax of Seventy five cents (75¢) on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of value as of July 1st, 1949. Seventy cents (70¢) of which is hereby levied for the general purpose of the city, and five cents (5¢) for the upkeep of the Fire Equipment.

Upon all real and personal estate within the City limits of Dry Ridge, Ky., and all personal estate except such tangible personal property as has a actual bona fide situs without the city of Dry Ridge, or persons domiciled or actually residing in the City of Dry Ridge, Ky, on the first day of July, 1949, and of all corporations having their chief offices or places of business in the City of Dry Ridge, Ky., on said date and all franchises of same except those exempt from taxation by the Constitution or laws of the State of Kentucky and the same shall be assessed at their fair cash value estimated at the price they would bring at a fair voluntary sale, and also all franchises or corporations owned or having their chief offices or places of business outside the City of Dry Ridge, Ky.

There also is levied a poll tax of one dollar (\$1.00) and fifty cents (50¢) on each male person over twenty one years of age residing within the City of Dry Ridge, Ky. A 6% penalty and interest will be added if not paid by May 1st; following the enactment of this ordinance.

This ordinance shall take effect after its adoption and publication as required by law.
