

ORDINANCE NO. 123

An order to amend and supplement Ordinance No. 117, thereby making it to conform with the Statutes (KRS) enacted by the 1950 Legislature of Kentucky.

Whereas, the Board of Trustees of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky deeming it a necessity and for the best interests of its residents; that sidewalks and curbing be constructed along and on either side of Church

ORDINANCE NO. 123 (CONTINUED)

Street in the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, according to specifications set out in Ordinance No. 117; do ordain as follows:

To amend and supplement Ordinance No. 117 to read that it shall be designated and known as a "stage improvement", and that the total cost of this improvement shall be paid exclusively by the abutting property owners. That said property owners shall have the option of paying for this stage improvement on the installment plan as is provided by Chapter 94 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes.

To supplement Ordinance No. 117 by adding thereto the following provision; the clerk of the City of Dry Ridge, after the passing of this ordinance as required by law, shall be authorized to advertise for bids for this "stage improvement" and may require cash deposits or other guarantees from the bidders to insure compliance with their bids, with forfeiture to the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, if the bid is accepted and the bidder fails to comply with his bid.

Read in regular meeting of February 6, 1951. All members voting "yea" to take effect as of its passing after publication as required by law.
