

ORDINANCE NO. 124

An ordinance to regulate and control the movements and parking of automobiles, trucks and other gasoline and oil propelled vehicles in the corporate limits of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky.

WHEREAS; It being for the best interests of the residents and property owners of the City of Dry Ridge and the Board of Trustees deeming it a necessity to regulate and control the movements and parking of automobiles, trucks, and other gasoline and oil propelled vehicles in the Corporate limits of the City of Dry Ridge.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Trustees of the City of Dry Ridge do ordain as follows:

SECTION I. No person in charge of a motor vehicle shall permit the engine thereof to operate or run for a period longer than 15 minutes, in the corporate limits of the City of Dry Ridge, between the hours of 10 P.M. and 6:00 A.M., while said vehicle is in a parked position, unless said vehicle is being serviced by a bona fide garage.

SECTION II. No person shall operate a motor vehicle in the corporate limits of the City of Dry Ridge, at a speed greater than 35 miles per hour.

SECTION III. No person in charge of a motor vehicle or truck or other gasoline or oil propelled vehicle shall permit same to be parked or stopped whereby it blocks the right-of-way, street, sidewalk, or driveway to other vehicles, or permit same to prevent access to a fire hydrant.

SECTION IV. Trucks and motor vehicles may drive over and across curbs and sidewalks for the purpose of loading and unloading but shall not block sidewalks to pedestrians, and motor vehicles must be moved immediately when loading or unloading is completed.

SECTION V. No person in charge of an automobile, truck or other gasoline or oil propelled vehicle shall park on either side of Main Street, in the City of Dry Ridge, in front of commercial establishments for a period longer than two hours (2); between the hours of 6 a.m. and 6 p.m. except Sundays. This section does not apply to the area in front of and maintained by the Carlsbad Hotel.

SECTION VI. Sections 3 and 4 of this ordinance shall not apply to garages, service stations or parking lots except that the operator thereof shall not permit sidewalks to become blocked so as to force pedestrians into the street or road.

ORDINANCE NO. 124 (CONTINUED)

SECTION VII. Bicycle riding and roller skating is prohibited on Main street; but shall be permitted on all sidewalks provided same does not interfere with or endanger pedestrians and any law enforcement officer shall have the authority to prohibit reckless riding or skating on any of said sidewalks.

SECTION VIII. Any person who violates any section of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$100.00.
