

ORDINANCE NO. 125

An ordinance to repeal Ordinance No. 121 and to regulate construction, re-modeling and demolition of buildings in the City of Dry Ridge, Ky.

Whereas, the Board of Trustees of the City of Dry Ridge, Ky. deeming it a necessity and for the interest of its citizens, do ordain as follows:

Ordinance No. 121 is hereby repealed and upon the passing of the following Ordinance:

That any person or persons planning to construct, remodel or demolish a building of any kind or description, commercial, residential, industrial, barn, warehouse, garage, privy, or any other building, shall before the commencement of construction, remodeling or demolishing, appear before the Board of Trustees of the City of Dry Ridge and for the purpose of obtaining a permit for such construction remodeling or demolishing, and before said permit shall be issued the applicant shall satisfy the Board of Trustees as to the location and building line, sanitation, sewerage, drainage, chimneys and flues, and material to be used, and the applicant shall pay the City of Dry Ridge, Ky. \$10.00 for the issuing of such permit and shall be subject to inspection at regular intervals during constructing, remodeling, or demolishing by an inspector employed by the City for such purposes.

Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined \$10.00, and each day said violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.
