

ORDINANCE NO. 127

An ordinance to regulate the production, transmission, processing, handling, sampling, examination, grading, labeling, regrading and sale of milk and milk products in the City of Fry Ridge, Ky., the issuing and revoking of permits to milk producers and distributors, the placarding of restaurants and other establishments serving milk and milk products, and fixing of penalties for violation of this ordinance.

Be it ordained by the City of Fry Ridge, Kentucky, by the Board of Trustees:

Section 1. The production, transportation, processing, handling, sampling, examination, grading, labeling, regrading, and sale of all milk and milk products sold for ultimate consumption within the City of Fry Ridge, Kentucky, or its police jurisdiction; the inspection of dairy herds, dairies, and milk plants; the issuing and revocation of permits to milk producers and distributors; the placarding of restaurants and other establishments serving milk or milk products, and the fixing of penalties shall be regulated in accordance with the rules of the State Board of Health of Kentucky as adopted under Sections 211.010, 214.010 and 217.060 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes and in accordance with requirements of the United States Public Health Service Milk Ordinance and Code, certified copies of which have been placed on file in the office of the City Clerk; provided, that the health officer as defined in rules of the State Board of Health and United States Public Service Milk Ordinance and Code, is the health officer of Grant County, or his authorized representative.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, association, or corporation to bring into or receive into the City of Fry Ridge, Kentucky, for sale, or to sell or offer for sale, therein, or to have on hand for sale any milk or milk products, excepting evaporated milk, condensed milk, condensed skimmed milk, powdered whole milk and powdered skimmed milk, who does not possess an unrevoked permit from the health officer of Grant County.

Such a permit may be revoked by the health officer upon the violation of holder of any of the terms of this or any other health ordinance of the City of Fry Ridge, Kentucky; provided, that the holder of said permit shall, after complying with such revocation, have the right of appeal to the Board of Health.

Section 5; From the date on which this ordinance takes effect, no milk or milk products shall be sold to the final consumer, or to restaurants, soda fountains, grocery stores, or similar establishments, except Grade "A" or Trade "A" pasteurized. This section shall not be construed as forbidding the sale of lower grades of milk and milk products during the temporary periods of degrading, not exceeding 30 consecutive days, or, in emergencies, such longer period as health officer may deem necessary.

Section 4. Any persons, firms or corporations violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) and not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00 for each offense, and each such sale shall be deemed a separate offense.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect sixty (60) days from and after its passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
