

ORDINANCE NO. 145
(Amending Ordinance No. 140)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ADDING TO
ORDINANCE NO. 140 OF THE CITY OF DRY
RIDGE, SAID AMENDMENT STATING THE
PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE REVENUES AND
PENALTIES ARE TO BE USED.

THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE DOES
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That ordinance No. 140 be and the same is hereby amended
and added to by the addition of a new section to be known as
Section 13, said Section to read as follows, to-wit:

SECTION 13. All revenues received for payment of
license taxes and penalties required by this ordinance shall
be paid into and become a part of the general funds of the
City, to be used for the general operating expenses of the
City.

This ordinance to be in full force and effect from and
after its passage and publication as required by law.
