

ORDINANCE NO. 147  
(Amending Ordinance No. 128)

AN ORDINANCE CORRECTING AND AMENDING  
ORDINANCE NO. 128 PROPOSING TO ANNEX AND  
ANNEXING CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY  
TO THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that there has been an error in the description of Tract No. 1 of Ordinance No. 128 and in order to correct said error,

NOW THEREFORE THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS;

SECTION I. That Tract No. 1 as described in Section No. 1 of Ordinance No. 128 which heretofore has read as follows, to-wit:

Tract No. 1

Beginning at a point in the present corporate limits of the City of Dry Ridge, 175 feet South of Broadway between the property of F.M. Neal and E.J. Blackburn; thence in a Southerly direction across Ralph Street a distance of 700 feet, more or less, thence in a N.E. direction, parallel to Ralph Street, a distance of 250 feet to a point approximately 150 feet south of the junction of Ralph and Judith Streets; thence in an eastwardly direction a distance of 165 feet, more or less, to the present corporate limits of the City of Dry Ridge, on the property line between Viola Bennett and R.C. Yelton.

Be corrected and amended to read as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the present corporate limits of the City of Dry Ridge, 150 feet South of the centerline of Broadway and in the common property line between F.M. Neal and E.F. Blackburn; thence, in a Southerly direction and parallel with the line of Judith Ave. and crossing Ralph St. a total distance of 960 feet, more or less, to a point; thence, in a Northeasterly direction, parallel to and 150 feet Southeast of (measured at right angles to) the South line of Ralph St. a distance of 355 feet, more or less, to a point; thence, in an Easterly direction and parallel to the Southerly line of Ralph St. a distance of 72 feet, more or less, to point in the present corporate limits of the City of Dry Ridge, said point being in the common line of lots 7 & 8 of Blackburns Subdivision.

ORDINANCE NO. 147 (Continued)

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
