

ORDINANCE NO. 165

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE STANDING OR PARKING OF VEHICLES ON THE SOUTHWEST SIDE OF MAIN STREET FROM THE INTERSECTION OF BROADWAY AND MAIN STREET SOUTHWARD TO AND INCLUDING THE AMBULANCE DRIVEWAY OF THE ECKLER FUNERAL HOME IN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Board of Trustees of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky to be for the best interest and safety of persons using the parking facilities on Main Street in the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, that parking on the southwest side thereof, be limited to two hour intervals in the hereinafter designated area.

NOW THEREFORE THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. No vehicle shall stand or remain parked on the Southwest side of Main street from the intersection of Broadway to Main Street southward to and including the ambulance driveway of The Eckler Funeral Home in the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, for a period longer than two hours between the hours of 6:00 A. M. and 6:00 P. M. excepting Sundays and holidays.

SECTION II. Any owner or operator having charge of any vehicle which remains standing or parked in violation of Section I of this Ordinance shall be guilty of misdemeanor and fined for the first offense the sum of 1 dollars and for the second offense not less than 1 dollars nor more than 25 dollars.

SECTION III. All resolutions, ordinances, or parts thereof in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.

SECTION IV. If any clause, paragraph, or section of this ordinance be invalid such invalidity shall not affect the remaining clauses, sections, or paragraphs, it being hereby expressly declared that such remainder would have been passed despite said invalidity.

SECTION V. This ordinance shall be effective upon its passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
