Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Dry Ridge, Grant County, Kentucky, in regular session for business on Monday night, July 1st, 1912, a full quorum of said Board being present and acting:

That it shall be unlawful for any person to allow a vicious dog to run at large upon the streets of the said Town of Dry Ridge. Mentucky, and any person or persons violating this ordinance shall be fined in any sum from One Dollar (\$1.00) per day to Five Dollars (\$5.00) per day for each and every day that such dog is allowed to run at large upon the streets of said Town of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, after it has been proven to be a vicious dog and the appearance of such dog upon the said streets, whether for a few moments or for a few hours in any twenty-four (24) hours, shall constitute an offense in the meaning of this ordinance.
