ORDINANCE NO. 192

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCES No. 137 AND OTHER ORDINANCES FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATIVE BODY. THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND CERTAIN OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: Section VI of Ordinance No. 137 is hereby amended and corrected to read as follows, to-wit: "The duly appointed and acting City Attorney shall receive as compensation for his services the sum of FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00) per month which shall be full compensation to him for any and all services rendered by him for the City. This shall include the usual and ordinary duties heretofore performed by him, including the prosecution of any and all cases required in the Police Court and any, and all, legal matters assigned to him by the City Council."

SECTION II: Section V and VI of Ordinance No. 137 are hereby amended and corrected to read as follows, to-wit: "There shall be collected and paid into the General Fund of the City by the Judge of the Dry Ridge Police Court the sum of NINE DOLLARS AND FIFTY CENTS (\$9.50) from each and every person, firm and corporation convicted of the violation of any offense triable in and by the Dry Ridge Police Court. This sum shall be in lieu of other court costs heretofore provided by ordinance."

SECTION III: All ordinances, resolutions, or parts thereof in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION IV: If any section, clause or paragraph of this ordinance be declared to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining sections, clauses or paragraphs hereof, it being hereby expressly declared that said remainder of said ordinance would have passed despite such invalidity.
