

AN ORDINANCE CALLING FOR AN ELECTION BY THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, TO DETERMINE WHETHER AN INDEBTEDNESS OF NINETEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$19,000.00) SHALL BE INCURRED BY SAID CITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING A NEW FIRE ENGINE, SETTING THE DATE OF SAID ELECTION, SETTING THE FORM OF QUESTION TO BE VOTED UPON, REQUESTING THE GRANT COUNTY COURT CLERK TO HAVE THE BALLOTS PRINTED AND DELIVERED TO ALL PRECINCTS OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, AND REQUESTING THE GRANT COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION TO COUNT THE SAID VOTES AND TALLY SAME AND CERTIFY THE RESULTS TO THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, AND AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF THE COSTS OF SAID ELECTION.

WHEREAS, it has been heretofore determined by the City Council of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, that the Kentucky Inspection Bureau has ordered the City to acquire a new fire engine or suffer an increase in fire insurance rates.

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, that an election be held to determine whether or not the said City shall incur an indebtedness of Nineteen Thousand Dollars (\$19,000.00) for the said new fire engine.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: It is hereby ordered that an election be held by the qualified voters of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, to determine whether or not they are in favor of incurring an indebtedness of Nineteen Thousand Dollars (\$19,000.00) for the purpose of purchasing a new fire engine for said City.

SECTION II: It is hereby ordered that said election be held on the regular ~~general~~ election day to-wit: On the 8th day of November, 1960.

SECTION III: The form of question which shall be placed on the ballots for said election is as follows: "Are you in favor of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, incurring an indebtedness of Nineteen Thousand Dollars (\$19,000.00) for the purpose of purchasing a new fire engine for said City and the levy of an additional tax of Twenty-Five Cents (\$.25) on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of taxable property in said City to provide a fund of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) annually for the repayment of said indebtedness with the proceeds of said additional tax levy to be used exclusively for the purpose of repaying said indebtedness. _____ Yes _____ No."

SECTION IV: It is hereby ordered that the City Clerk and/or City Attorney on behalf of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, request the Clerk of the Grant County Court to have the necessary ballots with the above question thereon printed and delivered to all precincts in the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, to and request the Grant County Election Commission to count, tally and certify the vote on said question to this Council. All of the foregoing is hereby ordered to be the expense of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky.

SECTION V: All ordinances, resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith, are to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION VI: If any section, paragraph or clause of this ordinance be found to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining section, paragraphs or clauses, it being expressly hereby declared that the remaining parts of said ordinance would have been passed despite such invalidity.
