

ORDINANCE NO. 197

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL PERSONS OWNING OR HAVING IN THEIR POSSESSION LOTS OR PARCELS OF LAND TO KEEP THE WEEDS THEREON MOWED AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: All persons, firms or corporations owning or having in their possession any lot or parcel of land within the corporate limits of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, shall at all times keep the weeds, underbrush, etc., thereon mowed, so that same does not present an unsightly appearance.

SECTION II: The City Clerk is hereby ordered, upon complaint to him that any such lot is not so kept, to notify in writing the owner or person in possession of said lot to mow same within ten (10) days or he will be cited to Court for violating this ordinance.

SECTION III: If, after said notice has been given for ten (10) days, the said lot has not been mowed, the City Clerk is hereby authorized to have same mowed at City Expense and charge the cost thereof on the City Tax Bill for said lot.

SECTION IV: Any person, firm or corporation cited into Court under this Ordinance and found guilty of violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be fined a sum of not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00).

SECTION V: All ordinances, resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith, are to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION VI: If any section, paragraph or clause of this ordinance be held to be invalid by a proper court, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining sections, paragraphs or clauses, it being hereby expressly declared that same would have been passed despite such invalidity.
