

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING EACH LOCOMOTIVE OR ENGINE OF ANY RAILROAD COMPANY RUNNING OVER ANY LINES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, TO BE PROVIDED WITH A WHISTLE OR HORN AND REQUIRING SAID WHISTLE OR HORN TO BE SOUNDED AT ALL PLACES WHERE THE TRACK CROSSES ANY HIGHWAY OR CROSSING AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF SAID ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by this City Council that the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Dry Ridge, can be best served by the requiring of the sounding of a whistle or horn by railroad locomotives at crossings within the City,

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: Every railroad company shall provide each locomotive or engine running over any lines within the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, with a whistle or horn of the ordinary and usual size.

SECTION II: When any such engine or locomotive is being operated inside the City Limits of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, the said whistle or horn shall be sounded at a distance of at least fifty (50) rods from any place where the track crosses upon the same level of any street, highway or crossing.

SECTION III: Any person, firm or corporation found guilty of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined a sum of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each such offense.

SECTION IV: All ordinances, resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION V: If any section, paragraph or clause of this ordinance be held to be invalid by a proper Court such invalidity shall not affect the remaining sections, paragraphs or clauses, it being hereby expressly declared that the remainder of said ordinance would have been passed despite such invalidity.
