ORDINANCE NO. 199

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A TAX ON ALL REAL AND PERSONAL PREPERTY OR ESTATE AND UPON THE SHARE OF CAPITAL STOCK OF ALL STATE BANKS AND/OR TRUST COMPANIES LOCATED WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, DOES OR-DAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: A tax of Seventy-Five cents (\$.75) on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of value as of January 1, 1961, is hereby levied upon all real and personal estate or property located within the corporate limits of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky; and all personal estate, except such tangible personal property as has an actual bona fide situs without the Corporate Limits of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, on the 1st day of January, 1961, and all corporations having their offices or places of business in the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, on said date and all franchises of same, except those exempt from taxes by the Constitution or laws of the State of Kentucky, same to be assessed as provided in ordinance No. 159 heretofore passed. Seventy cents (\$.70) of the above levy is hereby levied and declared to be used for the general purposes of the City and Five Cents (\$.05) of the above levy is hereby levied and declared to be used for the City's Fire Fighting equipment.

SECTION II: There is also hereby levied a poll tax of One Dollar and

Fifty Cents (\$1.50) on each male person over 21 years of age residing within the corporate limits of the City of Dry Ridge, K ntucky, except those exempt by the Statutues and Constitution of Kentucky, from said poll taxes.

SECTION III: There is also hereby levied a tax of Twenty Cents (\$.20) on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of the fair cash market value of the shares oof capital stock of each state bank or trust company doing business or located in the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky,.

SECTION IV: All of the above taxes shall become due and payable on the lst day of November, 1961, and if same are not paid before March lst, 1962, than a penalty of six percent (6%) together with interest at the rate of six percent (6%) per annum shall be collected on all such faxes as are not paid before March 1, 1962,.

SECTION V: All ordinances, parts of ordinances or resolutions in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION VI! The invalidity of any section, paragraph or clause of this ordinance shall not affect the remaining sections, paragraphs or clauses it being hereby expressly found and declared that the remainder of said ordinance shall have been passed despite such invalidity.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
