That it shall be the duty of all property owners, owning property within the corporate limits of the said Town of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, to proceed at once with their annual clean-up of their respective part or parts of the public streets and alleys of the said Town; also, of their vacant lots and back yards, including barn yards and gardens; also, their toilets; and to free all of the above property of weeds, leaves, trash, litter, garbage and rubbish and waste material of all kinds within the next ten (10) days from the date of this ordinance.

That if the above is not obeyed within the limit herein given, the Marshall of this said Town of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, is hereby authorized, directed and empowered to enforce this ordinance at the earliest possible date after the expiration of the limit herein given.
