

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO AND MAKING A PART OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, CERTAIN TERRITORY. SAID TERRITORY BEING FULLY DESCRIBED IN SECTION I.

WHEREAS the City has heretofore by proper ordinance proposed to annex the hereinafter described territory, and

WHEREAS, said ordinance has been properly published and posted as required by law and no petition has been filed protesting said annexation,

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I; That it deems it necessary and desirable and does hereby annex to the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, the following described property:

BEGINNING at a point in the present corporate line 300 feet north of north right of way line of Taft Highway and 30 feet west of center line of the McCoy Road thence in a line parallel to and 30 feet west of the center line of McCoy Road 1675 feet, more or less, in a northerly direction to a point on the lands of W. O. and Halliday Blackburn thence in a line parallel to the present corporate line in a westerly direction a distance 750 feet, more or less, to the right of way line of I-75/a distance of approximately 1675 feet to a point in the present corporate line thence in an easterly direction along the present corporate line to the point of the beginning. ^{Highway} ^{thence in a southerly direction and along the ROW/} ^{I-75}

SECTION II: All ordinances and/or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its' passage and publication according to law.
