### ORDINANCE NO. 782-2014

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, GRANT COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AMENDING CITY OF DRY RIDGE ORDINANCE NO. 739-2008 RELATING TO AND CONCERNING THE LICENSING OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE AND DINING-FOOD SALES AT RESTAURANTS AND DINING FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, did heretofore enacted City of Dry Ridge Ordinance No. 739-2008 pursuant to KRS Chapters 242 and 243, allowing and licensing the local vending and on-site sale of limited alcoholic beverages with food within restaurants;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, did enact City of Dry Ridge Ordinance No. 777-2013 pursuant to KRS Chapter 243 and under Senate Bill 13 (SB 13) amending the said Ordinance No. 739-2008 to so designate the city's local moist 70/30-beverage license to the type and category of a 'Combination NQ-2 Retail Drink License'; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Dry Ridge, Grant County, Kentucky has determined that beneficial business considerations concerning local licensing fees and renewals must be addressed and so dictates an amendment to City of Dry Ridge Ordinance No. 739-2008 at Section III thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, GRANT COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

#### General Article One

That City of Dry Ridge Ordinance No. 739-2008 and City of Dry Ridge Ordinance No. 777-2013 regarding the local licensing and sale of alcoholic beverages within the City of Dry Ridge as heretofore enacted, be and the same is/are hereby duly reaffirmed, readopted, and re-ordained save as hereby and hereinafter amended.

#### General Article Two

Section III under Issuance and Renewal of Licenses as Subsection E. Renewal: is amended as follows:

# "SECTION III" "Issuance and Renewal of Licenses"

B. Renewal: A license issued pursuant to this ordinance shall authorize the sale of alcoholic beverages for one year. The license may be renewed annually thereafter upon a showing of compliance with applicable regulations and the payment of a renewal fee of Eight Hundred Dollars for the initial or full licensing-year beginning on calendar-July 1, or at an amount and sum, greater or lesser, as may be determined or calculated by proration or adjustment, as the case may be, to reflect a changed licensing-period, or to match a requisite state licensing-term beginning other than on calendar-July 1.

This ordinance shall become effective and be in full force and effect when the same is duly adopted, approved, ordained, ordered published, and published according to law.
