

MUNICIPAL ORDER #0683-1

AN ORDER BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A FUND TO RETAIN REVENUE FOR THE FUTURE ACQUISITION OF A NEW CITY PUMPER.

WHEREAS, the City of Dry Ridge is in dire need of a new City pumper for their fire department, and

WHEREAS, the City of Dry Ridge is not financially able to purchase said pumper now,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF DRY RIDGE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

That the City of Dry Ridge shall establish a Fund for the Future Acquisition of a new City Pumper for use by the Dry Ridge Volunteer Fire Department, and

SECTION II

That said Fund shall be incorporated into the annual budget of the City of Dry Ridge for fiscal year 1983-1984, and thereafter at the discretion of the current City Council.

SECTION III

That \$3000.00 shall be the amount to be put into the aforesaid fund for fiscal year 1983-1984, and at the discretion of the City Council of Dry Ridge thereafter.

SECTION IV

That whatever amount of money not used by the City Council of Dry Ridge for any particular fiscal year shall be deposited into the fund enumerated in this municipal order.
