

MUNICIPAL ORDER 0984 - 1

A MUNICIPAL ORDER AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE TO EXPEND THE SUM OF EIGHTEEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$18,500.00) FOR THE PURCHASE OF A SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT.

WHEREAS, the City of Dry Ridge, pursuant to an agreement with the City of Williamstown and Locust Ridge Apartments must purchase a sewage treatment plant to handle sewage in the Dry Ridge area,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF DRY RIDGE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE

That the Council of the City of Dry Ridge hereby authorizes the Mayor of the City of Dry Ridge to expend the sum of Eighteen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$18,500.00) for the purchase of a sewage treatment plant from J.B. Company.

SECTION TWO

That the City of Dry Ridge is not bidding for the purchase of a new sewage treatment plant due to emergency existing, in that the City must purchase a new sewage treatment plant prior to October, 1984 pursuant to an agreement with the City of Williamstown, and the availability of this particular sewage treatment plant is rare and the City of Dry Ridge must act quickly to be able to purchase said plant. The city does not have time pursuant to the above, to put out bids, etc... for the above said purchase.

SECTION THREE

That this Municipal Order shall take effective immediately.
